The band will bring their own in-ear monitor system. We need four (4) aux feeds for these from the house console; three stereo, mutual for both guitar players and one each for bass player and drummer. We have two wireless systems and a wired system for the drummer. Everything is line fed, we don't use guitar/bass cabinets

In-Ear-Monitor Mix:

For Guitarist: They will share the same stereo mix and they want have overall balanced mix and all channels open.

For Bassist: CH12 (Bass), CH 1-8 (Drums) and CH 15 (VOC R) louder than the rest of the channels. CH12 is the usually on the top.

FOR Drummer: CH 1-11 (Drums) LOUD, CH 19-21 (Backtrack and click) and CH 13 (GTR R) a bit louder than the rest of the channels

From the venue we will also need:

- three (3) long boom mic stands for the vocals on the front
- **power on stage**, 1 behind the rack and one for each musician (3) on the front and one for the drummer as well

The channel list included on the next page is suggestive, and will be applied depending on the situation.
