We need two microphones on stage. 1 for primary vocals and 1 for backing vocals. We assume that the house sound engineer and lighting technician are qualified and serious about their tasks.

Usual equipment:

Vocal: Microphone, the best the house can offer

Guitar 1: Hughes & Kettner Grandmeister 40 tube amp + cabinet with four 12" speakers. 8-string guitar.

Guitar 2: Mesa Boogie tube amp. Mesa cabinet with four 12" speakers. 7-string guitar.

Bass: Darkglass Amp with DI Out in XLR. Speakon connector. Ashdown Bass cab.

Drums: 2 Bass drums, 1 snare drum, 3 cymbals, 4 toms, 1 ride cymbal, and 1 hi-hat. 2x hi-hat (bringing own stand for HH no. 2) 5x crash with boom arm. 1x ride with boom arm! (Bringing own stands)

Intro and effect PAD. Requires stereo line-in cable from stage to mixer (for our sounds/intros) Minimum 2x power connections on stage for the drums (220v).


Optional equipment in smaller venues, packing light or on tour:

Guitar 1 : Kemper Player to FOH. 1 XLR out.

Guitar 2 : Neural DSP Quad Cortex to FOH. 2 XLR out.

Bass: Darkglass B7K pedal, to FOH. 1 XLR out.

*Drums, vocals and the effect PAD are the same in both equipment scenarios.



Setup: Guitar 1 on the stage's right side, drums in the middle at the back, vocals in the middle at the front, bass and guitar 2 on the stage's left side. Backup vocals on the left side.

Monitor preferences: One monitor for each musician, with sound from all in each monitor. Additionally, we have a backdrop, and if possible, side drops on stands.

Backline - in case SHADOWSPAWN provides a full backline:

Guitar 1: Hughes & Kettner GrandMeister Deluxe 100 watt, 2 x Orange cabs 2x12, and 1 Orange 4x12

Guitar 2: Mesa Boogie Triple Rectifier 100 watt, 1 Mesa Cab 4x12

Bass: Microtubes 900 v2 amp, 2 x 4x12 Ashdown cabinets (optional Darkglass B7K pedal)

Yamaha RTC drum kit 2x 22" bass drums Toms: 8x8", 10x10", 12x10", 14x12", 16x14" Gibraltar rack with 10x arms for cymbals
